PREVIOUS COACHING EXPERIENCE

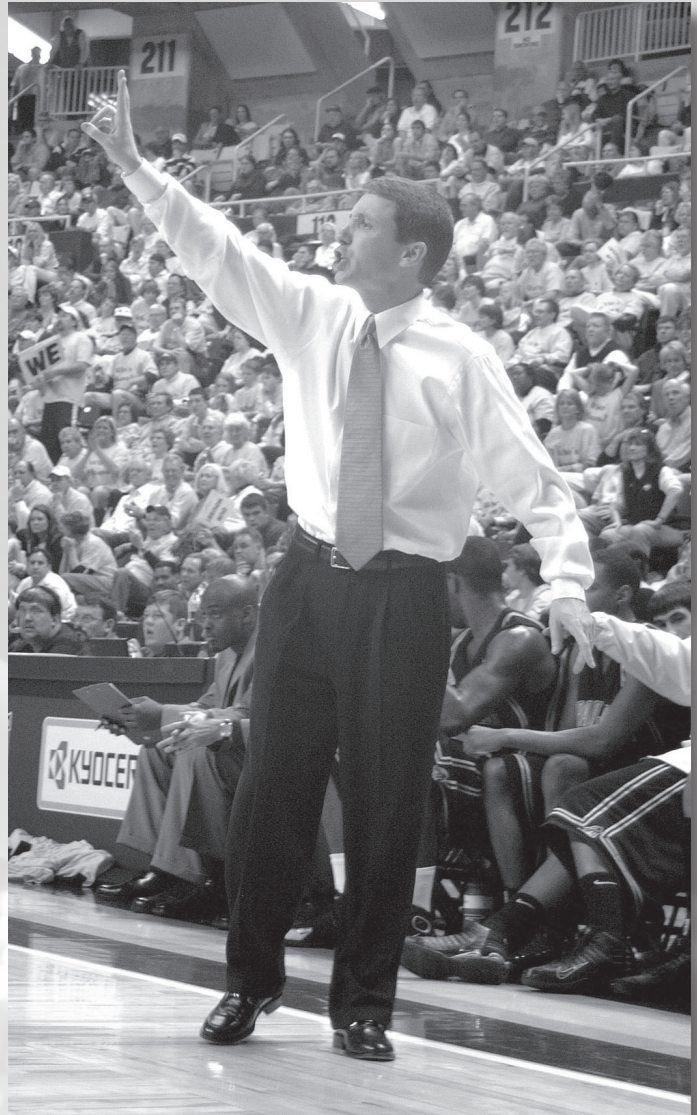
